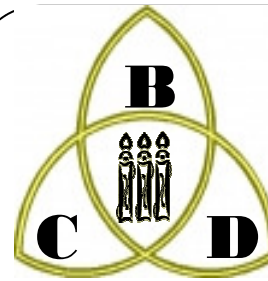
Following the Bishop being asked for guidance, he has put forward some candidates who will be interviewed by the selection committee in March.
